
University of Washington Standards









Conceptual Sketches of the "Wayfinding Map"

The wayfinding map at Husky Stadium helps attendees find their seat location. There is currently no Wayfinding Map in the Stadium.




$Conceptual\ Sketches\ of\ the\ "Wayfinding\ Map"$

The Wayfinding Map is made to be legible within a 10 foot radius. The sign is also elevated for limited interruption.

The Wayfinding Map is mounted on the walls of Husky Stadium. The sign includes brushed aluminum. There is a light mounted on the bottom to make the map visible in the dark. The Huskies "W" will be illuminated with a purple backlight.

Conceptual Sketches of the "Tunnel Numbers"


The current tunnel signs are in above every entrance to find the seating. There are 53 tunnel signs in the stadium.

The sign is illuminated in purple for night use.




Simulation of the "Tunnel Numbers"









Plan View of the "Ticket Entrance"




Simulation of the "Ticket Entrance"

The Husky stadium is host to sporting events and when the stadium is not being used, the area surrounding the stadium is a parking lot.




Simulation of the "Plaza Corners"

The restrooms at Husky Stadium look like the other signage but purple is the primary color. The men's room has an image representing broad shoulders and the women's room represents a skirt.


